The competition for Nevada Rangers Shootist of the Year – 2010, was an ever changing race right up through the October shoot. First one Ranger was ahead, then another, then even another. Shootist of the year for 2010 was based on the most number of clean stages shot by a Ranger for 2010 (possible number of clean stages was 41). Competition was open to all Nevada Rangers with dues paid by January 31, 2010.

Sheriff John T Chance and Georgina were presented with their award at the annual Nevada Rangers Christmas Social in December 2010. Sheriff John T Chance was also presented with a set of John Wayne glasses for having the most number of clean stages for 2010.

Shootist of the Year for 2011 will be based on a point system. Each member will receive 100 points for each monthly match shot. Another 100 points will be awarded for each clean monthly match. One point will be deducted for each miss, 2 points deducted for each procedure, 10 points deducted for minor safety procedures, 20 points deducted for stage disqualifications, and 20 points deducted for each stage the shooter does not complete during a monthly match.

Shootist of the Year is open to all members of Nevada Rangers with dues paid as of January 31, 2011. Cowboy and Cowgirl Shootist of the Year for 2011 will be awarded at the annual Nevada Rangers Christmas Social in December 2011.
